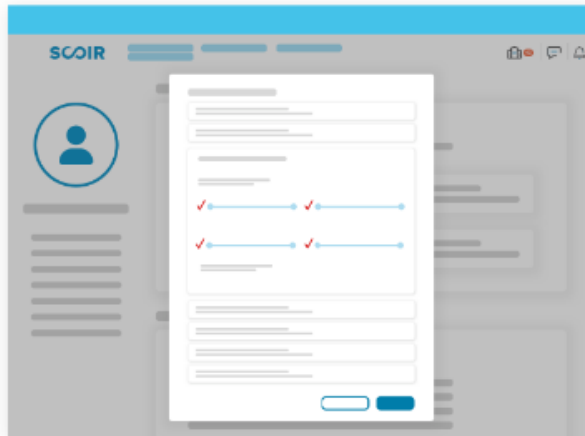




Application Season Reminders



Hi there,

Your student's high school uses Scoir to manage & send college application documents.

This season, we are excited that your senior will also be able to [apply to over 140 colleges and counting with Scoir](#).

When students apply with Scoir, their information will be pre-populated from their Scoir profile. Plus, they can make progress on multiple applications at once, turning the application process into a much quicker and easier experience.

If a school on your student's list doesn't accept applications from Scoir, we encourage you to familiarize yourself with these best practices for alternate application methods to ensure a smooth process:

1. Student profiles in Scoir should match the information used in their college applications: In order for colleges to more easily match the application documents you send to the right individual, students should confirm they're using the same first name and last name, email address, DOB, etc. in Scoir as they are on the applications they've submitted to their colleges of interest. 2. When students apply with other application methods other than Scoir, they should add application IDs where applicable. While not required, these IDs are another way colleges link

application documents to the correct applicant record.

3. Students should submit their application before moving the college to the Applied column in My Colleges. When students complete these steps in this order, counselors will know exactly when to send documents on behalf of your student.

Students can update this information via My Profile & My Colleges within Scoir.

We already reminded your student and school counselors, but we know when we all partner together, students succeed. Check-in with your student when you have a moment.

Rest assured, regardless of whether a student's information in Scoir matches perfectly with what they submit, supporting application documents will still be delivered to the appropriate colleges. Documents are never lost with Scoir. Confirming synchrony between the two sources of information—your student's Scoir Profile and their college applications—is just one simple way you can help that administrative process move along as quickly and seamlessly as possible.
